Allison Schmitt to Attend 2013 Aquafest Event



In her Olympic debut at the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing, Allison Schmitt won a bronze medal as a member of the 4×200 -meter freestyle relay. Four years later, at the 2012 Summer Olympics in London, she won a total of five medals, three of them gold, in the 200-meter freestyle (in which she set a new Olympic record), in the 4×200 -meter freestyle relay, and in the 4×100 -meter medley relay (in which a new world record was set); and she also won a silver medal in the 4×00 meter freestyle, and a bronze medal in the 4×100 meter freestyle relay.

In total, Schmitt has won fourteen medals in major international competitions: nine gold, three silver, and two bronze spanning the Summer Olympics, the FINA World Championships, and the Pan Pacific Championships. She was also a four-time National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) national champion in the 200 and 500-yard freestyle swimming events during her collegiate swimming career at the University of Georgia. Along with other Bulldogs, she won the NCAA Division I Women's team title in 2013.

In regards to her tremendous success, Schmitt has said: "I didn't start swimming competitively until I was 10 and didn't really focus on it until I was 12, yet it's such a huge part of my life and I can't imagine my life without it. It's been an amazing journey, but more than that, it's shaped who I am as a person."
