The park with the most votes wins a \$100,000 recreation grant. 2nd place wins \$50,000 and 3rd wins \$25,000. With just a click of a button, people can vote for Moana Park and Stadium at www.LivePositively.com/parks.

We have until July 15, 2012 at midnight EST to vote.

Sign up for Foursquare – a location based social networking application and you can register 100 votes every time you "check in", all from your smartphone. Just go to Moana Park and Stadium, log into Foursquare and "check in". It is that simple. You can check in up to 3 times per hour, 28 times per day, so every time you drive by Moana – check in.

Signing up for Foursquare is easy.

<u>Step 1:</u> Go to https://foursquare.com/download to download the free foursquare application to your smartphone.

Step 2: Set up a foursquare account.

<u>Step 3:</u> Follow the directions on the LivePositively.com/parks desktop or mobile site to register your foursquare account with the campaign site and accept the application permissions.

<u>Step 4:</u> Now you are ready to go to the park and vote. Once you are there, voting is as easy as pulling out your smartphone, opening the foursquare app and "checking in".

Aquafest 2012 Featured Athlete: Rowdy Gaines

Rowdy has one of the most inspirational stories in all of sports. Missing the U.S. Boycotted 1980 Olympics didn't end Rowdy's career, it ignited it! After taking a year off, Rowdy returned to the 1984 Olympics an underdog but emerged a winner and it doesn't stop there. In 1991 Rowdy was diagnosed with Guillan-Barre Syndrome, paralyzing him for over two weeks; not only did he recover, he went on to win 2 World Masters Titles and broke 2 World Masters Records the following year.

He is known as one of the world's most dedicated, as well as, ambitious athletes and symbolizes the American quest for more than gold. Today, Rowdy Gaines is often referred to as "Swimming's Greatest Ambassador." Known as the voice of swimming, he has worked with CBS, TNT, ESPN, and NBC as an announcer for swimming and other events. He travels the

world passionately sharing his love for the sport of swimming with youth, parents, and coaches.
