City of Reno

Idlewild Pool - Open June 7 through Sept. 8. Closed June 14-16 and Sep. 6-7. Outdoor 50-meter, eight-lane pool with two 1-meter boards and a tot pool.

Traner Pool - Open June 7 through Aug. 4. Public swim 1 to 4 p.m. daily. Outdoor 25-yard pool with slide and water play features.

Deer Park Pool - Open June 8 – August 11 Noon to 4:30 p.m. M-F and 11 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.
