Adopt-A-Pool 2012

Sierra Nevada Community Aquatics (SNCA) would like to thank everyone who attended last year's Adopt-A-Pool at the Idlewild and Traner pools. The amount of people that came out to help with last year's event met our expectations and exceeded the City of Reno's. Although not the most glamorous of work, everyone rolled up their sleeves and DOVE IN. On the main event day of Saturday June 4th we had over 110 volunteers from most all of the user groups and even some of the neighbors of Idlewild Pool area.

The City of Reno has announced that the Idlewild and Traner pools will open for the 2012 season!!!

SNCA is happy to bring to you the 2nd annual Adopt-A-Pool **Tuesday May 29th – June 7th**

Last year's volunteer effort was a feather in the cap of this aquatic community. We would love to see this event grow even larger this year! So mark those calendars for the week of May 29th – June 7th. The City of Reno is hopeful that they have added enough chemicals to the pool water over the winter so we won't have to scrape the pool floor and sides this year. Let's keep our finger crossed.

Adopt-A-Pool Schedule

Tuesday May 29th - 10am to 2:30pm

<u>Duties</u>: Pressure washing and clean out of pools, painting. A large pump will be used to drain the pool and this takes most of the first day. The green slime that is exposed as the water line drops must be cleaned off while it is still wet as to minimize staining the pool surface.

Wednesday May 30th - 7:30am to 2:30pm

<u>Duties</u>: Finishing wash-down of pools and clean-out of surge tank, painting. There will be repairs needed to the tile around the rim of the pool and portions of the pool surface. The City has these tiles and patch materials in stock and some of the existing tiles will be reused after a little cleanup is done to them. Some of these may be lying in the bottom of the pool and will be retrieved when the pool is drained.

Thursday May 31st - 7:30am to 2:30pm

Assist with tile repairs, fill pool, painting.



Friday June 1st - 7:30am to 2:30pm

Assist with pump and solar system start-up, touch up painting.

Saturday June 2nd - Adopt-A-Pool Day – 10am to 1pm

Remove weeds and rake planter beds, weed removal in playground adjacent to pool, planting for pool beds, sweep entrance and parking lot, hose and squeegee bath house/pool deck, clean windows, cleaning out getter drains, installing wind screens on fence, painting.

Tuesday June 5th - Thursday June 7th - 7:30am to 2:30pm Traner Pool

The City of Reno will need volunteers to help with cleaning, painting, repairing expansion joints, assistance with building preparation and pump

start up. The Traner plan has the same basic functions as the Idlewild Pool.

All you need to bring is a few tools you may have: rakes, gardening equipment for planting, covered shoes that can get wet, clothes appropriate for painting and most of all, your willingness to help the aquatics community.

Aquafest 2012

long festivity, with a fun, all-ages swim meet in the morning, where participants will have a chance to swim with and against the athletes. Then in the early evening, we will have a family BBQ and pool party at Idlewild Pool and Park.
